TELEGRAM.

The Governor of the East African Protectorate
to the Secretary of State for the Colonies.

(Received, Colonial Office, 6.45 p.m. 14th January,
1914.)

No. 11. Governor of Uganda has informed me that he proposes shortly to undertake punitive measures against Turkana and has applied for permission to cross our border if necessary to follow up offenders. I have signified my consent and have despatched officer to Uganda to ascertain how we can best assist. In the meantime serious raids by Uganda and East African Turkana are reported from Mbarti resulting in number of Samburu villages being wiped out and large quantities of stock looted. These people have regularly paid hut tax to our officers in Northern Frontier District. It seems probable that original plan of action proposed by Uganda will require to be altered considerably. Will keep you informed of developments and will report proposed action as soon as possible.

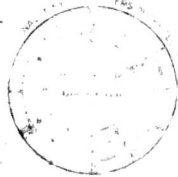
