Sir,

I have the honour to report that the Inspector General of Police has received a communication from the Editor of the "East African Standard" regarding that engraver, watches may be presented on behalf of Messrs. Anderson and Meyer to save European Police Officers in recognition of the valuable services rendered by them during the fire which destroyed the premises of the firm on the night of the 21st of August last.

2. It was to a great extent due to the assistance afforded by these officers that the fire did not assume large proportions and that a considerable quantity of personal property was saved from the burning building; their efforts also included the removal and safeguarding of inflammable stock stored in adjacent premises, which were in imminent danger of being involved in the conflagration.
