No. 24 My telegram 14th January No. 11  
after consultation with Uganda have decided that it is  
imperative that operations against Turkana should be  
commenced at once. Owing to situation in North-  
East of Protectorate I can only provide half company. .  
Uganda can furnish 4 companies and operations will be  
carried on in both Protectorates under Colonel Ward.  
Total cost estimated at £4,000 part of which probably  
will be recovered from disaffected section. Propose  
that net cost of operations should be divided between  
two Protectorates equally. At the conclusion of  
military operations Uganda would take over military  
control of all Turkana pending decision of ultimate  
policy of administration. Inspector General, King's  
African Rifles approves military arrangements indicated  
above and agrees as to necessity for operations.  
Request authority to proceed at once. Cost will be  
met as far as possible from savings. Have forwarded  
copy of this telegram to Governor Uganda who concurs.
