I have the honour to acknowledge the receipt of your despatch 6.1039 of the 5th ultimo relating to "The Pawnbrokers Ordinance 1913" and to express my regret that by an unfortunate discrepancy the rate of profit on loans is variously stated in Part I of the Second Schedule and Part II of the First Schedule, whereas it should in both cases have read as 6 cents for every two rupees or part of two rupees.

2. I am advised that an amending Ordinance will be necessary and that pending its enactment at the next session of the Legislative Council the rate of profit must remain at the lower of the two rates mentioned, viz: 6 cents for every two rupees or part of two rupees.
