With reference to your despatch No. 91 of January 30th, which I regret has remained so long unanswered, I have the honour to inform you that there will be no increased cost of the proposed amendment to the regulations, as provision has always existed in the Estimates for payment of allowances to officers occupying their own houses at the rates now recommended.

2. Certain officers have been drawing rates of House allowance in excess of those allowed by the Regulations and I am calling upon Heads of Departments for an explanation in connection with this.

3. I trust that you will now be able to approve of the recommendations contained in my despatch No. 994 of December 23rd, 1913.
