THE LAND TITLES REGISTRATION AMENDMENT ORDINANCE 1914.

MEMORANDUM.

1. The Land Titles Amendment Ordinance 1910 among other things dealt with the method of registration of documents affecting land for which a certificate of ownership had been given under the Land Titles Ordinance 1908 or the Land Titles Amendment Ordinance 1910 and prescribed that such registration should be effected by making a copy in the Register vide Section 23. It is obviously of advantage that the quicker method of registration provided by the Registration of Documents Amendment Ordinance 1914 and the Registration of Documents Further Amendment Ordinance 1914 should also apply to the registration of documents under the law relating to Land Titles and the Land Titles Registration Amendment Ordinance 1914 is designed for that purpose.
2. The Ordinance may in my opinion be assented to and published without prior reference to the Secretary of State.
