I have the honour to refer to my despatch No.91 of January 27th last and in accordance with Section 8 of the Collective Punishments Ordinance 1909 to inform you that the communal fine of 1,000 head inflicted on the Woran of the Il Merisho Clan of the Purko Masai has been collected in full without difficulty.

2. The total number of casualties amount to 204 being mainly deaths from Fast Coast Fever. Forty bullocks have been taken over by the Director of Agriculture for the Kabete Government Farm and the remainder have been commandeered by the Military Authorities
