In the cases of those officers who have foregone considerable portions of their leave it may be found advisable that they should return to this country before the completion of a full tour of twenty months' service in the Prots. and, if you think fit for special reasons, ~~to do so~~ the tour in the cases of those officers may be reduced to twelve months.
