WHEREAS Colonel Sir Edouard Percy Granvill Girouard Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Companion of the Distinguished Service Order while holding the Office of Governor of the East Africa Protectorate by Order under his hand and Official Seal dated the 5th day of September 1911 did in exercise of the powers conferred upon him in the said Office of Governor by the East Africa Order-in-Council 1902 Article 25 (1) order the Honourable Galbraith Cole to be deported from the East Africa Protectorate to the United Kingdom NOW THEREFORE in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by the East Africa Order-in-Council 1902 Article 25 (5) I, Henry Conway Belfield, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander in Chief of the East Africa Protectorate, do hereby rescind the aforesaid order of deportation.
