TELEGRAM. The Governor of the East Africa Protectorate to the Secretary of State for the Colonies.

(Received Colonial Office 8.20 p.m. 4th November, 1914)

November 4th.

Have just received intelligence that attack was made upon German position at Longide this morning by a body of our troops composed of Kapurthala Infantry 29th Punjabis 27th Mountain Battery and East African Mounted Infantry under the command of Colonel Drew. He reports troops in action since dawn. Heavy mist at night made surprise impossible. Serious opposition met by both columns. No communication between columns possible by heliograph. He anticipates (ed) considerable difficulty in taking and retaining the position and calls (ed) for strong reinforcements immediately. Regret to report that our casualties were as follows: Killed: Captain Hugh Handley Sanbach, late 1st Royal Dragoons, address Cheney Hill, Malpas, Cheshire, one Sepoy Kapurthala Infantry, two Sepoys 29th Punjabis. Wounded severely: Lieutenant Dudley Halswinsten Maskard, 27th Mountain Battery, father lives at Florence, three Sepoys, 29th Punjabis. Wounded slightly: eleven Sepoys, 29th Punjabis. Enemy's casualties four Europeans and one African killed. Further particulars will be telegraphed as soon as received.
