In accordance with the authorisation faceived by your telegram signed "Private" of the 26th. Movember, I have the honour to report that I am making preparations for my journey and hope to leave for Moyale in the first week of January, taking Mr. Mafiro, whose leave is now due, with me.

It will take a month to reach koyale and a further month to Nairobi, and 1 shall spend two or three weeks if necessary at the former place, where I hope to see Fiteureri Waldi and Canazmatch Gashi, visiting such points on the frontier as Mr. Hope may think advisable.
