With reference to Your Excellency's despatch No. 262 of July 6th. regarding the transit and transshipment regulations for Jubaland and Italian Somaliland, I transmit herewith copy of a telegram from the Governor of British East Africa concurring in the new draft of Article 2 subject to the amendment proposed in the Foreign Office letter to the Colonial Office of July 17th, enclosed in my despatch No. 216 of July 28th. His Majesty's Government are therefore prepared to accept the article subject to the omission of the last three words "for re-embarkation there" and the substitution of the words "for transshipment without being actually landed ^{or passed through} in British territory". His Majesty's Government also accept the proposed additional article submitted in Your Excellency's despatch above referred to. The question
