with reference to my despetch No. 28 of the 22rd ultime, I have the honour to report that on that day a fresh attach upon to Albertville, take fanganika) was made by the Jerman steamer referred to in the telegram from this Office of August 25th, towing a barge and accompanied by two tugs and a motor launch, upon which was mounted a machine gun.

The Jerman steamer and tags were armed with 3.7 game and shelled the position, keeping out of range of the selpian 7 5 gam. Under cover of this fire the motor launch with the machine gun endeavoured to effect a landing, but was beaten back by the belgian machine gun.

The belgian steamer, which was lying at Albertville
was completely destroyed by the shell fire. It was an
old one of about 18 tons, but the only one the Belgians
had
