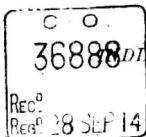

Sir,

In reply to Mr. Read's letter of the 23rd
September 1914 No. 36065/1914, I am directed to inform you
that the Last Pay Certificate enclosed therein for
Lieutenant A.S. Coffin, 28th Punjabis, attached Supply and
Transport Corps, lately serving with the 3rd Battalion
King's African Rifles, does not seem to be sufficient to
dispose of the case.

Lieutenant Coffin was entitled, under the
arrangement for loan of services of Officers of the Indian
Army to the King's African Rifles, to passage at the
expense of Protectorate Funds from Nairobi to Bombay.
Having been permitted to take leave to Europe before
rejoining his unit in India he came to this country, taking

an



an advance of Rs. 480, being approximately the amount of passage money due for the journey to Portbay. No mention of this advance is made in the Last Pay Certificate, and it is thought that the advance of Rs. 480 may have been mistaken for the pay due for the period 1st to 31st June 1914 which would amount approximately to Rs. 420 and which Lieutenant Coffin states he has not received.

I am therefore to request that you will be so good as to ask the Pay authorities at Harrod to issue, if necessary, an amended Last Pay Certificate in view to a final settlement of Lieutenant Coffin's pay.
