COPY TELEGRAM ~~FROM~~ GENERAL ATTORNEY, MOMBASSA.

1832. Your telegram of 5th and 6th Nov. 1914.  
In absence of complete information we can give no  
decision yet, but you may temporarily return to  
Mombasa and there formulate proposals in communication  
with naval and civil authorities as to your future  
operations. You will consider whether operations are  
still possible or whether all your Force should  
operate in British East Africa. Pending final  
decision on these points you may send reinforcements  
and such other troops as you may consider desirable.  
You must clearly understand that all Force "A" must be  
retained in East Africa and that no announcement of  
recent events should be made by you or other authorities  
in East Africa. Warn officers accordingly.
