Sir,

I have the honour to inform you that a proposal has been made to introduce trout into various cold water streams of the Protectorate in a proper and scientific manner.

2. At present there are trout in the Gura River rising in the Aberdare Hills and they have done very well and there is no little doubt that they will flourish in other rivers equally well.

3. Forester G.H. Minshall has taken a keen interest in the fish and has attempted to make an artificial hatchery but with no result. He is proceeding to England on leave in November and I recommend that facilities be given him to study at some properly managed fish hatchery the various methods employed in breeding fish and the general management of the young fry.

4. If this proposal is approved I have the honour to request that arrangements may be made through the Board of Agriculture and Fisheries for Mr. Minshall to begin his studies shortly after his arrival in England as I believe the spawning season starts in November.
