The effect of this telegram as I understand it is to confirm the interpretation of Gov 37979 given in our telegram of the 20th of November on that paper. But Sir P. Girouard with his usual infallibility in these matters has expressed himself in the way which would most handicraft us if and when we eventually tie to the Treasury again. One would gather from this telegram that there was on the 1st of April last an available balance of \$147,310 and that a further balance of \$17,810 will be accumulated in the course of this year's working so that the total available balance on the 1st of April next will be \$164,820.
