East Africa Protectorate.

Sir,

I have the honour to transmit, in original to be returned, an Indent which we have received from the Government of the East Africa Protectorate for silver coin to the nominal value of Rs. 50,000, in *25 cent pieces.* We understand that the Royal Mint would probably be unable to commence the manufacture of this coinage for about two months we have approached the Birmingham Mint in the matter and have received from them the following quotation, viz:-

11/- ^s/_d per 1000 pieces packed and delivered f.o.b. London or Liverpool; delivery in about three weeks after the receipt of the necessary silver and dies.

3. We shall be glad to receive the Secretary of State's instructions in the matter.
