Uganda Railway - Lake Magadi Railway.

Sir,

I have the honour to acknowledge the receipt  
of your letter of the 3rd May, No. 13013 enclosing a copy  
of a despatch from the Governor of the East Africa  
Protectorate laying down certain stipulations as to the  
shipment of materials for the construction of the Magadi  
Railway, and requesting that we will observe these in  
respect of materials for which we are responsible.

2. We notice that by paragraph 37 of the contract  
lately signed the Administration is required to spend  
£203,500 for certain rolling stock and works for the  
efficient working of the railway in connection with the  
contract. These appear to be the only materials for the  
shipment of which we shall be responsible. Indents for  
them will no doubt reach us in due course, and we will  
see that when shipping these materials the wishes of the  
Governor are complied with.

3. I may however point out that the Governor's  
letter probably applies to materials to be sent by the  
firm that will construct the railway. We would there-  
fore ask to be informed whether the Governor's wishes have  
been brought to the Company's notice by the Secretary of

regulation of shipments.
