HEREAS by treaty, grant usage, sufferance, and other lawful means, His Majesty has power and jurisdiction without the East. Africa and Ugunda Protectorates in this Order referred to as "the Protectorates"):

And whereas by the East Africa and Uganda (Currency) Order in Council, 1905 (in this Order referred to as the Order of 1905). The East Africa and Uganda Currence) Order in Council, 1906, in this Order referred to as the Order of 1906, and the East Alorea and Uganda Currence) Order, 1910 (in this Order referred to as the Order of 1910), provision is made with respect to the currency of the Pententiurates, and it is expedient to make further provision with respect thereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, His Majesty, in pursuance of the powers vested in Him by the Foreign Jurisdiction Act, 1890, or otherwise, in pleased, by and with the advice of His Privy, Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

- . The Order of 1905 shall be read and have effect as if-
 - (a) The following paragraph were substituted for paragraph (2) of Article (3) of that Order
 - (2) The Corrency Board shall have a head office at Nairebl, and a branch office at Mombasa,

and also, if the Secretary of State so directs, at Enterbee, and may employ such officers and persons as may be from time to time authorized by the Commissioner";

(b) The following provision were inserted at the end paragraph (I) of Article 14 of that Order:

either at the head office or at any branch office, of the Currency Board.

or 3. The holder of a currency note wherever issued shall be entitled to obtain on demand during office hours at the head office of to-turrency Board payment in current even of the amount expressed in the note.

> "16 A currency note shall be a legal tender in either of the Protectorates, of the amount expressed therein, except a tender by the Curvency Board at their head office":

Provided that nothing in this Order shall affect the night of the holder of a currency note issued before this Order comes note operation to obtain payment of the note at the office of the Currency Board at Mombasa.
