
Sir:-

With reference to my letter No. 592 of the 11th January last, I am directed by Secretary Sir Edward Grey to transmit to you herewith a copy of a Despatch from His Majesty's Agent and Consul General at Zanzibar stating that the Zanzibar Government agree to the proposal that their claims to the mainland properties of the Sultan should be settled by the Land Titles Court in East Africa.

Mr E. Gray would be glad if, as requested by Mr. Clarke, due notice may be given as to the date upon which these claims will be heard so that arrangements may be made to have the interests of the Zanzibar Government represented.
