With reference to your letter 2470 of the 6th instant on the subject of the Anglo-Italian Commission on the Juba river, I am directed by Secretary Sir E. Grey to state, for the information of Mr. Secretary Harcourt, that according to the opinion expressed by both Hall and Oppenheim in their works on international law the words "mid-channel" and "thalweg" are identical in signification. Both words should be distinguished from the expression "medium filum aquae", which indicates the middle of the stream irrespective of the actual channel.
