Sir:-

After more carefully considering the matter of the clove industry in Zanzibar and Pemba submitted for your consideration in my Memorandum of the 28th March, I have come to the conclusion in consultation with my friends that it is almost impossible to arrive at either a fixed price or a fixed annual Rent for the Government owned clove and coconut plantations which will certainly be fair to both sides. I therefore venture to withdraw the proposals made in that previous letter, and to submit in their place the scheme set forth below:

- (1) The Government of the Islands (Zanzibar and Pemba) to grant a 99 years lease of the Government owned plantations out of all "duty cloves" now collected in the above Islands.
- (2) The rent to be based on the average net income derived by the Government during the last 10 years from the above sources, such amount to be determined by an independent authority.

Under Secretary of State,

(3) Each succeeding year's rent to be determined by dropping the first of the ten years and reckoning a new average by the inclusion in its place of the last year's net income. But

(4) the minimum rent payable in any year during the currency of the lease to be that paid in the first year even should the average drop from any unforeseen cause. By this means the Government obtains security against carelessness on the part of the lessetholders or from any other cause and also guarantees at least minimum revenue.

(5) The Government to receive half of the net profit, to be made by the lessetholder from the Government estate and duty clippings,

(6) The Company to undertake to spend £10,000 further developing the clove industry and in making new roads, etc., to the plantations.

(7) The lessetholder Company to have a subscribed capital of £100,000 when the lease is signed.

(8) Or, as an alternative, we are prepared to purchase on the basis of cash.
