Sir,

In the circumstances represented by Mr. Secretary Harcourt in Mr. Fiddes' letter of the 4th instant (10535/1911), the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury sanction an expenditure from the funds of the Protectorates concerned of £2,000 on such preventive measures as the Governors may consider most urgently necessary for controlling the outbreak of rinderpest in East Africa and Uganda.

My Lords will await the further report which they gather will be obtained from the local Governments explaining in detail the nature of the measures adopted, the allocation of the expenditure between the two Protectorates, and the means taken for re-couping so far as may be possible the actual cost incurred. So far as it can not be met by imposing special charges or taxation every possible effort should be made to effect the necessary savings.
