No. 12. Your telegram 18th December existing system
 of surface drains only effective over very small area of
 the island. At the present moment contour survey of the
 island is in hand which will enable town-planning
 Committee which has been considering question since 1909

 is completed Public Works Department will prepare
 estimate for necessary drainage system meeting all
 requirements of the Health authorities. It is not expect-


