2. We had before lis the very full and comprehensive Handing-Over Report compiled by Mr Archer, and also these documer ts are enclused herewith.
3. You will percelve that in the opinion of both these officers tre most pressing problem which confronts us at the moment is the treatment of the Marrehan, and that they agree in thinking that unlegs wo take dectstre action trandateks sanginney interf tifbal warfare whextnevitably resulat ase the tatarmy Who have hitherto refrained from setaliatory action in the belief that we will pretect them, cannot is

4. In view therefore of the urgency of the case and or the complete concurrence of Colonel Thesiger I have, in anticipation of your sanction, which I feel confident will not be withheld, authorised Mr Hope on his return to the frontier 0 inform cre chiefs of the Garro that it is the intention of the
 country at the time of the nexi 1100 d of the orliba. Mr Archer is to be sent there at the ame time, and he will get into touch with the various chiefs and make himself acquainted with the customs and organisation of the tribe. He will give them clearly to understand that the Government, while not proposing to take any action in regard to past delinquencies, will allow no further raiding amongst the neighbouring tribes and will, if necessary, employ troops to prevent it.
5. It is hopad that no display of force will be required; but in order that it may be forthcoming, if needed, I am increasing the garrison of the post at Sorenly.
6. In order to provide for the nccesuitso or tnís station it is essential that some syistem of military transport should be organdeed forthwith. I have therefore authorised the 0 . C. Troops to purchase 106 camela and to incur expenditure amounting to e400 on the transport service generally up to June 30 th. I have given this date as one prior to which I shall
have had an opportunity of discussing the whole question with you and Colonel Thesiger. The urgenoy of the situation has compelled me to give these instruotions without taking financial considerations into account, but the necessary adjustment will not, I Hope, present any epecial difficulties, and delay would in the opinion of all concerned be most danger -

7. I have remarked above that in estabilshing relations with the Marrehan $I$ propose to ignore all raids and acts of aggression which have taken place in the past phere is however one case which demends spacial treatment. Wile Mr Zaphiro was at Moyale the Marrehan Galti, under a ohief named Shirre, raided the Garre and looted 232 cattie belongine to the chief Gabbaba. Gabbaba's only son and brother were killed in the raide Major awynn R.E, subsequeritly visited the district and promised Gabbaba that he would be compensated for his loss. Finding himself unable to bring this about, he then stated that the Protectocate Government on assuming control of the frontier would rectify the matter.
8. Ty this promisa we are cleantit pound, and, as I think it-inadviaakla to sote any oxception to the general finesty for past misdeeds which it is proposed to offer to the Marrehen, I have instructed Mr Hope to give Gabbaba \& 8000 compangetion in cash. I trust thet you will epprove of this, which I consider unavoidable in the ciroumstances.
9. The other main, question effecting the Northern Frontier DIstrict io, as you will perceive from Mr Archeris-report, the distribution of the military Pores and their replacement in certain stations by a force of civil irregulars, whom it is proposed to designate Border Police.
