With reference to my confidential despatch No. 117 of the 27th December 1911, I have the honour to submit for confirmation the names of Messrs G. A. S. Mure, J. A. S. Elliot, G. St. J. Orde Browne and J. K. Pearson, all of whom completed their three years probationary service on the 14th instant.

2. The work of all of them has been satisfactory and they have passed the tests prescribed in language and law with the exception of Messrs Mure and Elliot. The former has been stationed in Subaland and has not yet passed either examination, and the latter has only to pass in one subject in the Law Examination.

3. I recommend them all formally for admission to the permanent staff. Messrs Orde Browne and Pearson immediately and the others on passing their examinations.

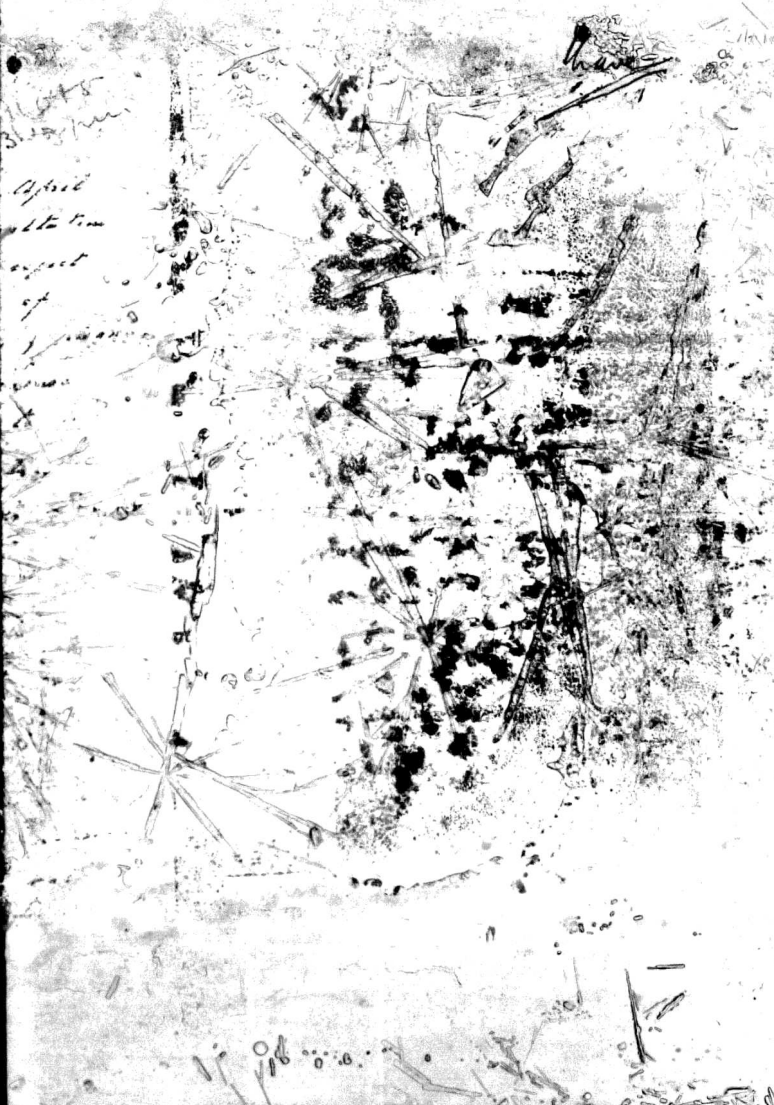
