Sir,

I have laid before the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury Mr. Adrobus's letter of the 12th ultimo (4138/1905) relative to a claim for £862.9.6 preferred by the Indian Government in respect of certain pensions and gratuities payable to the widow and son of Lieutenant-Colonel C.B. Maitland, I.M.S., who was killed in action in the Jubaland Province of the East Africa Protectorate on the 16th of February, 1901, during the military operations in connexion with which the loan of his services had been obtained from the Indian Government.

The claim is calculated on the following basis

- (a) The whole of the gratuities.
- (b) The computed value of the extraordinary portion of the pensions.
- (c) The computed value of the Jubaland Service share of the "ordinary" or remaining portion of the pensions.

In reply I am to request you to inform the Earl of Elgin that My Lords approve of this settlement, and concur in the payment of the amount in question from East Africa Protectorate funds to the credit of the Government of India.

This sanction is given without prejudice to any decision which may be arrived at on the recommendation of
