An agreement made this day of  
Between His Most Gracious Majesty King Edward VII 25 MAR 08  
Seventh of the one part and The East Africa Cotton  
Syndicate (hereinafter referred to as the Lessee) of the other part Whereby in consideration of the  
rent hereinafter reserved and of the covenants by the  
Lessee hereinafter contained or implied by virtue of  
the provisions of the Crown Lands Ordinance 1902 His  
Majesty doth hereby demise unto the Lessee all that  
piece of land situate in the Province of  
Tanganyika in the East African Protectorate comprising  
500 acres of theretofore to be selected subject to  
the approval of the Land Officer Excepting and reserv-  
ing all native or other rights if any to in or over  
the said land To hold the same unto the Lessee for  
the term of three years from the day of  
190 subject save where expressly herein otherwise  
provided to the provisions of the said Crown Lands  
Ordinance 1902 and especially the provisions contained  
in article 16 thereof and to the Rules for the time  
being in force under the said Ordinance Yielding  
and paying therefor for the said term the yearly rent  
of one peppercorn if demanded And the Lessee do hereby  
covenant with His Majesty his heirs and successors  
that they the Lessees will during the said term use  
the said land for the purposes of cultivating cotton  
only And that the said land shall be surveyed and the  
Lessee shall pay all the costs of such survey And it  
is agreed that when such survey has been completed a  
plan of the said land agreed to and signed by the  
Chief Surveyor shall be annexed hereto And it is  
further agreed that if before the completion of such  
~~survey~~ and annexure of the said plan as aforesaid any

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question arises as to whether any place is or is not  
within the land hereby leased the same shall be  
referred to the Commissioner of Lands whose decision  
thereon shall be final. And the lessees further  
covenant that they will give a copy of such notice  
to the said Procurator or his subordinates to be forwarded  
to the Governor and that service thereon or delivery  
at the said address of all notices and other documents  
shall be deemed good service upon the lessees And that  
the Lessees will not assign sublet or otherwise part  
with the possession of the said land on any part  
thereof without the previous consent of the Governor  
in writing And will pay Rs.15/- for every such  
consent and will pay the costs of the preparation of  
this agreement amounting to Rs.100/- Provided always  
and it is hereby agreed that the Lessees will during  
the first year of the said term plant with cotton  
50 acres of the land hereby demised And will during  
the second year of the said term plant with cotton an  
additional 100 acres of the said land And will  
during the third year of the said term plant with  
cotton an additional 200 acres of the said land .  
Provided always that if at the end of the term hereby  
granted the Lessees shall have planted with cotton  
and shall then have under cultivation not less than  
350 acres of the said land and shall have performed  
all the covenants hereby agreed by them to be performed  
His Majesty his heirs and successors shall grant to the  
Lessees a lease of 40000 acres of land to be  
selected by the Lessees subject to the approval of the  
Land Officer of which the land hereby demised shall  
form a part for a term of 30 years at a yearly rental

of Rs. 1500/- subject to the usual covenants and to the following special covenants:-

1. That the Lessees shall spend a sum of Rs. 5000/- in development of the said land in each year for five years.
2. That at the end of the first year of the term the Lessees shall have under cultivation 500/- acres of the said land.
3. That at the end of the second year of the term the Lessees shall have under cultivation 1000/- acres of the said land.
4. That at the end of the third year of the term the Lessees shall have under cultivation 1500/- acres of the said land.
5. That the Lessees shall at all times thereafter during the said term keep not less than 1500/- acres of the said land under cultivation.
6. That there shall be reserved to His Majesty his heirs and successors ~~all forest land~~ within the said area.
7. That the Lessees shall be at liberty at any time on giving to the Governor six months' previous notice in writing to surrender to His Majesty his heirs and successors [of] the said land.
8. That the Lessees shall have an option if they so desire of further extension of the lease of the said land for a term of 30 years on the same terms and conditions as hereby agreed to be granted (except the present condition of extension).
9. That the Lessees may use and take water from the River Tanna so long as it does not interfere with the navigation or existing rights subject to clause 7 of the said Crown Lands Ordinance.

1902 and subject to all other irrigation rules for  
the time being in force or which may hereafter be made  
provided that in the event of any dispute in regard  
to the use of the water of the said river between the  
same shall be referred to the Commissioner of Irrigation  
whose decision thereon shall be final.

Provided always and it is hereby agreed that the lease  
of the said 500 acres of land hereby demised shall be  
granted to the Lessees and the Lessees shall accept  
and execute the counterpart thereof when and so soon  
as it is tendered to them for execution and until the  
same is executed the parties hereto shall be bound  
by the covenants and conditions hereinbefore contained  
and agreed to be maintained in the lease as if the same  
were actually executed.

Sir,  
In further reply to your letter of the 5<sup>th</sup> of March,  
I am directed by the Bank  
of Abyssinia on behalf  
of your company  
to sign the accompanying  
draft agreement for  
lease to the S. A. Cotton  
Syndicate of cotton land  
in the Tigraland Province  
of the E.A.S.

2. The Govt. of the Prov<sup>c</sup>  
reports that the boundaries  
of the grant have only  
lately been defined and  
instructions given for  
survey, and that owing  
to the isolated position  
of the block, it is not
