RULES

Issued by His Majesty's Commissioner under the provisions of the Crown Lands Ordinance 1902.

(1) Rule 10 of the Rules issued under the aforesaid Ordinance and dated December 1st 1902 is hereby annulled.

(2) The scale of fees for survey purposes shall be as follows:—

Rs. 15 - for any survey up to and including 15 Acres.

1 - for every additional acre up to and including 40 acres.

45 - for any area exceeding 40 acres but not exceeding 50 acres.

(3) The revenue charge is calculated on the edges of land being approximately square in shape. If the cost of survey has been incurred by irregular or being long and narrow shape, the cost shall be determined by the Chief Surveyor. The fee charged shall be based on the length of the perimeter.

(4) An extra charge may be made for cases of land situated at a greater distance than 20 miles from the Uganda Railway to cover the cost of the transit. Such charge shall be determined by the Chief Surveyor.

(3.) The above scale is applicable on the blocks of land being approximately square in shape. In the case of blocks having irregular boundaries or being long and narrow in shape the foreshill boundary shall be determined by the Surveyor. The fee charged shall be based on the length of the perimeter.

(4.) An extra charge may be made in cases of land situated at a greater distance than 20 miles from the Jagannath Railway to cover the cost of the transit. Such charge shall be determined by the Chief Surveyor.
