My Lord,

With reference to Your Lordship's despatch No. 518 of the 16th ultimo I have the Honour to report that no Customs duty has as yet been paid on the material and fittings for the Boughton Knight Memorial Church.

2. A deposit of Rs. 675 was made on the 10th of January 1907 by the Church Missionary Society to meet the amount due for duty and though this was subsequently determined to be Rs. 588.57, the account has not as yet been adjusted.

3. This being the case, I have not submitted the matter for the consideration of the Legislative Council, but in view of the terms of Your Lordship's letter have directed the Chief of Customs to refund the deposit.
