(Received, Colonial Office, 11 a.m. 4th November, 1905)

No. 210. Your telegram of 3rd November. Following received from Smith. Begins. Mapping finished and boundary marks erected from Laitokitok to South end of Jipe. Some divergence of views between us and Schlobeach remains but it should be easy to arrive at a final settlement of the question in Europe. Proceed Zanzibar 12th November for longitude observation. Ends.
