No. 244. Referring to your telegram of 18th December

connection with girl under age twelve years with
consent is rape under Indian Penal Code.

Girl under sixteen taken out of possession of lawful
guardians without consent of guardians with express
intention of seduction is an offence under section
366 but not if girl at the time of leaving intends
to be party to illicit intercourse in which case offence
of abduction alone committed.

When arrangements have been made between
parties for handing over girl under sixteen for
illicit intercourse both parties guilty of offence
sections 372 and three. Native customs recognise
illicit intercourse between young men and unmarried
girls. From recollection of Judges report girls do
not appear to have been corrupted by Silhemud.
