In reply to Your Lordship's despatch No. 560 of  
 September 1841 relative to a request by Mr. J. A. Simson for an  
 increase of salary, the hon'ble report that, after  
 carefully considering the same, I consider that the  
 fact of his being one of the highest paid officers to Mr. Simson's  
 case does not justify an increase of salary, and would not  
 in itself justify an increase of salary. The legally  
 ascertained cost of living in Bengal is not a  
 sufficient reason for a favourable consideration of his  
 request and I have the honour to recommend that he be  
 granted an additional £100 per annum to his present salary.
