Officer Administering the Government of East Africa
Protectorate to Sir Lyttelton.

Received Colonial Office 9.35 a.m. 15th November, 1906.

No. 216. Following received from Smith. Demarcation effected Iaitokitch to Latema as in despatch of 15th July No. 369. Latema to Rufu River demarked on the basis of existing native rights which gives Germans seven square miles. I asked for Mohuru Point and centre line of Rufu River and half Jipe Lake in exchange. Captain Scholobach has given no formal answer yet but conversationally has asked for Kajera Mouth and other concessions to the west of lake and access for Chaga people to Useri and Kinnangalia Rivers. Consider question best discussed in Europe on arrival of maps. Hope no further work will be required in the field. Protocols of course reserve final decision to Governments.
