

In reply to Mr. Antrobus's letter (23262/1908) of the 17th instant, I am to say, for the information of the Earl of Crews, that the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury agree that the post of Senior Inspector of Farms in the East Africa Protectorate may during Mr. Scholefield's tenure, (only), carry pensionable rights.

I am however to point out that the salary of £325 per annum was assigned to the post on a non-pensionable basis; for the time during which the post will be regarded as pensionable the salary should in Their Lordships opinion be fixed at £300 per annum.
