My Lord,

I have the honour to state that I am deeply engaged in the exploitation of fibre on the Government area known as, Masongaleni Concession, British East Africa, which has been fully equipped with machinery and is producing sansevieria fibre, and, in connection with which Concession, I duly lodged the £1,000 under the Government regulations, which has been duly returned to me on completion of the equipment. I am now supporting Messrs. Dymond & Grant in connection with the two fibre areas upon the Sabaki River, of 50 square miles each, for which they have made application to the Government, standing in the names of Messrs. Handcock & Abbott, and which are liable to forfeiture and open to fresh applications owing to non-compliance with Government regulations.
