to be fixed with concurrence of Foreign
Office.

And follow up with short report explaining that
it was considered expedient to have this
Order and the Order providing for appeals
to the Council (from the new Appeal Court
passed simultaneously) to be brought into force
on the same day, & that this course
was taken.
