My Lord,

I have the honour to report that several cases have been brought to my notice where considerable damage has been done by elephants to the plantations belonging to natives and arabs near Malindi. To prevent as far as possible the continuation of such damage I have sanctioned the issue to certain well-known and trustworthy arabs of a Martini Henry rifle and a limited number of rounds of ammunition and I have the honour to submit for Your Lordship's favourable consideration the proposal, that in the event of any elephants being shot, the owners of the damaged plantations may be compensated from the proceeds of the sale of the ivory for any loss they may have sustained.
