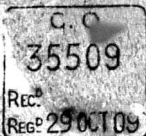

My dear Sir,

With reference to the question which you put
me on the 2nd September last, I am now able to give
you further statistics with regard to the liberation
of slaves in the East Africa Protectorate.

We learn from the Governor that up to the
31st of August, the number of slaves liberated was
1,001, and the total amount of compensation paid up to
the same date £14,885.9s.4d.
