Municipal Corporations Ordinance 1909.

---:O&O-O&O:---

This Ordinance was returned to the Legislative Council by His Excellency for further consideration of the provision of Section 63 Sub-section (5) which empowered a Municipal Council to make bye-laws for regulating or prohibiting the use of the sidewalks of any public street by Natives.

The Council deleted the Sub-section, and also corrected the clerical error in Section 63 (5).
