
Sir,

In the circumstances explained in Mr. Antrobus's letter (45571/1908) of the 16th ultimo, I am to request you to inform the Earl of Crewe that the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury now approve a total expenditure not exceeding £2,829 (of which £829 may be provided in the estimate for 1909/10) on the construction of a pier and monorail at Mombasa in the East Africa Protectorate, on the understanding (1) that the execution of the works contemplated for this outlay in no way commits His Majesty's Government to the approval of further extension hereafter (2) that adequate dues will be charged for the use of pier and monorail.
