I have laid before the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury Mr. Antrobus's letter of the 30th ultimo (12528/1909), relative to the case of the late Mr. E.L. Waring, Deputy Director of Surveys, Cadastral Branch, East Africa Protectorate.

In reply I am to request you to inform the Earl of Crewe that if, as My Lords understand Mr. Waring had actually been discharged from the service of the Protectorate on account of permanent incapacity before the date of his death, They consider that the gratuity of £350.0.0 for which he was eligible by length of service may be paid to his legal representatives.
