My Lord,

In reply to Your Lordship's despatch No. 650 of October 30th, I have the honour to report that the two areas referred to in paragraph 2 (1) as granted to Mr. Heatley are identical with those mentioned in paragraph 2 (2). The freehold rate of Rs.2 per acre was inserted in error and the actual rate charged was Re.1 per acre, for freehold and half anna per acre per annum for leasehold.

2. The deeds of Mr. Gale's grant were only registered on May 20th 1909 and appear therefore in the return of grants up to June 30th 1909.

3. I agree to the grant of a further 5,000 acres to Mr. Heatley referred to in paragraph 3 of Your Lordship's despatch and have given instructions accordingly.
