SABITAL - The fighting men of the TURKANA are reported to have collected on the East of Lake RUDOLPH.

The RENDILE are rather disquieted about the TURKANA.

Rains started, but ceased after ten days.

SABITAL - The ABYSSINIAN at JAMOK, ALI DE RUU, has arrested thirteen Somalis from British territory who were purchasing arms in Abyssinian territory. They have been sent to ADIS ABEBEA.

It is reported that a force of 300 Abyssinians under HUSSEIN camped at DOLIO and proceeded into British territory in pursuit of some HAFGAB. It is reported that owing to the activity of the MULLAH MAHOMED ABDULLA, the Somalis in Abyssinian territory are out of hand and have raided 5000 camels.

One hundred Abyssinian soldiers have arrived on the border under command of GANAZMAZ TEZAMBA who has received instructions from the Emperor to seize all hunters he may find in the vicinity of the border.

A number of BORAN who state they formerly lived in British territory, have crossed the border from Abyssinian territory. The Abyssinian officer at JAMOK asked Mr. BARRETT to return them, but he has refused to do so as they had committed no crimes.

Joint sickness called "Jesdor" by the Somalis, has broken out on the border.

Cattle sickness called "mudobore" has broken out at DUBBELI, KORONDIL and O'GORGI, which places Mr. BARRETT put in quarantine.

The GURE at EL WAK are reported to have bought 86 rifles from Somalis.

ABDUREHMAN MURSAAL is reported to be at FANNEN in the MARSHAN country with his own people and a number HAFGAB and ADEN KHATIR

riflemen

riflemen brought from Abyssinian territory by SILLE IBRAHIM. It is said that he intends to break away from Government altogether, and start an anti-Government policy.

Two Somali sections, MAHOMED NOTANA and HABIN SULIMAN have been fighting at SUDIE, WAJHIR, between themselves.

Mr. BARRETT visited WAJHIR and ordered the Somalis to leave that part and return to their own country.

Somalis from Jubaland are said to have been buying guns in Abyssinia.

MUSBAR UGAS, the HER AFMAR Chief is said to be at SIDINLA arranging a plan for an attack on the MAREHAN with ANDUREEMAN MUREEAL. The GUURE at EL WAK are said to have refused to assist.

It is reported that the MAREHAN raided tribes on ITALIAN side of the JUSA, and that the Italian officer at MERUZ crossed with troops and attacked the MAREHAN at HILMAHEERA and captured many prisoners and much stock.

Rains have been very good on the frontier.
