In view of the fact that a good deal of information regarding routes, and rough mapping done by Administrative efficers and others is expected to come in from time to time, the Survey Department must continually revise and compile such information. I have approved for the present of the employment of one of the surveyors of the Cadastral Branch on this work and I have directed that it should be carried out in concert with the Military Intelligence Officer.

The souls which has been selected for this class of compilation is 1:250,000 that is to say the scale of the series of maps of the Intelligence Division of the War.

These sheets are designed for general use and to form Provincial maps with farm boundaries.

when the Trigonometrical and Topographical programme foreshadowed is completed, it will be necessary to consider our further requirements.

By reducing the accuracy of the friganometrical frame work and by adopting Recommande methods of deriographs it is thought that extended areas may be mapped quickly, with accuracy sufficient for administrative and other purposes outside of the areas devoted to white settlement. This will require more detailed examination some years hence.

6. Last mail of ferwarded the annual report of the Director of Surveys, but owing to fear incidently's Circular of March 1808 time was not available for comments thereon. The report meets with my concurrence and will I hope satisfy Your Lordship of the continued good work of the Department. The annual report rendered will be the last to be furnished during

the Director of Surveys, and I would like to place on record my appreciation of the admirable services rendered by him to this Government during his tenure of his appointment.
