My Lords regret that these appointments have been described as pensionable in the letters which I addressed to various Veterinary Institutions asking that names for the posts may be recommended. As however they have been so described, My Lords recognise that pension rights cannot be negotiated without regard to the other legitimate offers and activities of their institutions upon the offer of £200 a year (if accepted) on a voluntary basis.
