Your telegram of 14th June, in order to make Port Hall road available for efficient steam or motor traffic larger expenditure necessary than I consider justifiable for this class of transport. Kasapa mono-rail complete failure and quite unsuitable for our even more hilly country. I inspected it and consider its construction waste of public funds. Much regret that after saving Treasury £40,000 estimated Jinja-Kakinda and being quite prepared to accept sum on same terms as Uganda it refused. Line is as justifiable as Jinja prospects excellent. It would be object lesson (in) cost of feeders for Uganda Railway main line. Am quite prepared to find total sum for construction out of specific savings and roads during next three years former estimated at £30,000 at least for 1911-12 but hope that Treasury if they agree can at least sanction £12,000 mentioned for mono-rail. Earnestly request your Lordships support in a reconsideration.
