1911.

Agency - but I should prefer us to  
put instant to telegraph to the  
fact that no copies of the leases  
referred to are on record here & ask

whether the terms of the  
concession to W. Tongue are now valid?  
in para 5 of the concession in the Govt's  
book No 184 of the 24<sup>th</sup> of March 1908

I think that would be the quickest  
surest way of getting at it.
