In addition to the above Larpoung Police are

What is supplied when necessary for the performance of their duties.

Each soldier is provided with a uniform, and is supplied with the necessary equipment.

Articles are issued to the person in the following manner:

- 1. Belts 15
- 2. Rifles 15
- 3. Pairs of Boots 15
- 4. Pairs of Leather Gaiters 15

(A) A Rifle should last a year.
 (B) 2 Sun Brown Belts should last a year.
 (C) Gaiters, with care, should last 20 months.
